## Conference Format

Preference may be given to sessions that actively engage participants and provide practical takeaways.

- Meet all conference deadlines and requirements

Limited travel expense assistance may be available for out-of-town presenters, subject to budget availability and conference requirements.

To be considered, applicants must submit:

### 1. Speaker Information

Complete the attached Speaker Information Form.

### 2. Session Overview

Provide a summary of your proposed presentation, including:

- Session title
- Learning objectives
- Key topics to be covered
- Intended audience
- Presenter qualifications

The session overview must not exceed one page.

### 3. Supporting Information

Applicants may optionally include a link to a video demonstrating previous speaking experience.

Please do not submit PowerPoint presentations, brochures, sales materials, or promotional documents.

## Selection Process

All proposals will be reviewed by the Conference Steering Committee.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Relevance to conference theme
- Educational value
- Practical application
- Presenter expertise
- Originality of content
- Anticipated attendee interest

Due to program limitations, not all submissions can be accepted. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision following the review process.

## Submission Deadline

**October 1, 2026**

Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

A maximum of three submissions per presenter is permitted.
